Animal Services officers investigate animal related calls. Services include animal bite reports, animal welfare and cruelty checks, rabies control, stray animals, and emergency response for sick and injured stray animals. Officers also enforce all State of Illinois and local animal ordinances in Winnebago County, helping to keep pets and people safer.


## Activity Calls by Municipality - 2023

Out of the over 7,400 activity calls that our Animal Services offers responded to, $66.72 \%$ of those calls were within the City of Rockford. Subsequently, $13.16 \%$ of those calls were to Winnebago County, 6.75\% were in Machesney Park, and $5.85 \%$ to Loves Park.

## Officer Activity

In 2023, Animal Services Officers handled over 7,400 calls. $40 \%$ of the calls were for a stray domestic animal, usually a dog running loose. Investigation for welfare, a bite, or barking made up $27 \%$ of calls. "Other" calls included other investigations (e.g. running at large, rabies vaccination/registration, animal fighting) and assisting other agencies (e.g. police, fire departments) or assisting animal owners.

## Field Service Outcomes

Officers responded to 7,444 calls in 2023. There are more outcomes than calls because more than one outcome was recorded for some calls. For example, if an officer impounded a stray dog and left a written warning for the owner, both outcomes were recorded for the call. The most common outcomes are listed below (except for citations, which are described in the following section). Warnings include both verbal and written. Other outcomes not specifically listed include: animal returned to owner, no service needed, unable to catch animal, owner or complainant not home, wild animal relocated, trap set/checked/picked up, and full compliance.

## Citations Issued

Officers issued 972 citations in 2023, both in the field and at the shelter. Of those, 425 were for rabies vaccination/registration or Code Hearing Unit "Notice of Animal Violation." The other 547 were "Notice to Appear" citations. The majority of those citations were for a dog running at large (371). Animal Welfare (48) includes Owner's Duties, Animal Cruelty, Aggravated Animal Cruelty and Confinement to Motor Vehicle.

## Animal Bites

In 2023, there were 713 animal bites reported to Animal Services. The majority $(75 \%)$ of the bites were from dogs, with $21 \%$ reported from cats. Bites were also reported for 29 other small mammals ( $4 \%$ of bites)

## Animal Rabies Testing

There were 56 animals sent to an Illinois Department of Public Health (IDPH) lab and the University of Illinois for rabies testing. The animals tested were dogs (24), bats (22), cats (4) and (6) other small mammals.
Reasons for testing include a human bitten by an animal, a domestic animal exposure to a wild animal, or a human possibly exposed to a wild animal (primarily bats in homes).

## Shelter and Adoption Services

## Kennel Visitors

Sign-in records show that over 9,100 people visited the shelter kennel areas in 2023. Most of the visitors indicated they were looking for a pet to adopt or trying to find their missing pet.

## Pet Registrations

In 2023, there were 45,422 tags sold within Winnebago County. $26 \%$ of the registrations were for cats and $74 \%$ were for dogs. Registrations were done at the shelter or area veterinary clinics.
Winnebago County pet owners are required to vaccinate and register all owned cats and dogs.

## Animals Impounded

During 2023, 5,096 animals were impounded. Of the 5,096 animals impounded, $39 \%$ were dogs, $51 \%$ cats, and $7 \%$ were wildlife. Other impounds (3\%) were other pets, primarily guinea pigs, domestic rabbits, rats and chickens.

## Adoption by Species

## Euthanasia by Species

During 2023, 987 animals were euthanized, compared to the 1,113 euthanasias performed in 2022.
Of the 987 animals euthanized $36 \%$ were cats, $24 \%$ were wildlife, and $39 \%$ were dogs. Other euthanasia (.40\%) consisted of two rats, one guinea pig, and one hedgehog.
